ENTRY **MUST** BE ON THE FORMS PROVIDED WITH THIS SCHEDULE. EMAIL ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED BUT **EXHIBITOR CHECKLIST** MUST BE SIGNED AND INCLUDED WITH THE ENTRY. **COPIES OF PEDIGREES MUST BE SENT WITH ENTRIES.** PLEASE CHECK TITLES AND ANY OTHER CHANGES ARE ACCURATE e.g. CHANGE OF SEX – DESEXED. **VACCINATION CERTIFICATES** WITH STICKERS ATTACHED MUST BE INCLUDED FOR KITTENS AND NEW COMPANION ENTRIES.

KITTEN ENTRY AGE

Kittens **MUST** now be **3 calendar months** of age to be shown. Litters can be shown up to **4 calendar months** and **MUST** include **ALL** living progeny.

AWARDS

Top 5 or 10 depending on numbers. If there are significantly large classes, additional places **MAY** be awarded at the committees' discretion. (If fewer than 5, numbers **MAY** be reduced)
Points for Cat of Year and Best of Breed issued in Rings 1-3. CCC of A also awarded in Rings 1-3

SUPREME EXHIBITS

Each group / ring judge will award a **Supreme Exhibit**. i.e. **L/H Supreme** and **S/H Supreme** plus **Supreme Companion** in each ring.

These placings will be used for **COY** points [10 pts per Supreme].

SUPREME LONGHAIR
SUPREME SHORTHAIR
And
SUPREME COMPANION

Will be determined on points.

NO EXHIBITOR

or **EXHIBIT** is permitted to leave the hall until **ALL** judging has been concluded. **THIS INCLUDES** awarding of **SUPREMES** without the permission of the Show Manager.

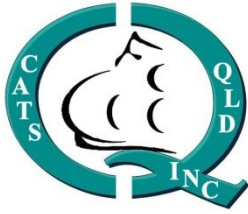

DEFINITIONS

KITTEN	Entire or desexed, at least 3 calendar months old and under nine months on the day of the show. Kittens MUST be registered by four months of age. Entire and desexed kittens compete together.
ADULT	Entire exhibits nine months or more on the day of the show.
ALTER MALE	Male cat or kitten that has been desexed including Companions.
ALTER FEMALE	Female cat or kitten that has been desexed including Companions.
LITTER	To consist of two or more kittens. All the living progeny of the birth belonging to one person or joint owners, not exceeding the age of four months on the day of the show. The number of kittens & sex must be stated on the entry form.
CHALLENGE	All adult cats up to the title of GOLD DGC will compete for challenges in open classes for each breed / colour class: [Male, Female, Alter Male and Alter Female.] Adults with titles of CQI PDGC and above compete for one certificate each for Male, Female, Alter Male and Alter Female per group.
COMPANION CHALLENGE	All companions over nine months compete for awards of merit. These can be used to title your companions. ALL COMPANION EXHIBITS MUST BE ALTERED BY 6 MONTHS OF AGE
CCC of A AWARDS	Are available to eligible TITLED adults and alters in each complete ring [excludes Specialty Rings] One certificate is awarded in classes of ADULT MALE, ADULT FEMALE, ALTER MALE and ALTER FEMALE – in each group, LONGHAIR and SHORTHAI** . 10 awards are required per level.

	I have included copies of the most recent and updated pedigrees of my exhibits. It is my responsibility to ensure that the show manager has proof of the most up-to-date for each exhibit as required. If your cat has been de-sexed since the last pedigree was issued, please ensure that your pedigree has been updated.
	I have included current copies of all of my kitten exhibit vaccination certificates and/or checked with the show manager that a current copy has been recently sighted.
	I acknowledge that I should not leave the show hall before the show is finished. If I remove the cage cards and pack up my exhibits before the end of the show and the issuing of awards and challenges, I may forfeit any awards and challenges that I could have received.
